

MISCELLANEOUS RECORDS AT LANDGUARD 2013

The following is a summary of miscellaneous casual records of a variety of species in the Landguard recording area during 2013. Many sightings, particularly of common species, go undocumented and the species list and dates should be treated as an absolute minimum.

Plants

STINKING GOOSEFOOT *Chenopodium vulvaria*
None found.

PYRAMIDAL ORCHID *Anacamptis pyramidalis*
One on a new position on the Butts TM2832 July 13th onwards. Last years not noted.

Fungi

SHAGGY PARASOL *Chlorophyllum (Macrolepiota) rhacodes*
Noted November 27th.

CHESTNUT DAPPERLING *Lepiota castanea*
Noted October to December.

Lepiota oreadiformis
Noted October to December.

GRISSETE *Amanita vaginata*
Noted October to December.

SNOWY WAXCAP *Hygrocybe virginea*
Noted October to December.

SOAPY KNIGHT *Tricholoma saponaceum*
Noted October to December.

FAIRY RING CHAMPIGNON *Marasmius oreades*
Common on the reserve.

FIELD BLEWIT *Lepista saeva*
Noted October to December.

WOOD BLEWIT *Lepista nuda*
Noted October 31st.

MILKING BONNET *Mycena galopus*
Noted December 19th.

COLLARED MOSSCAP *Rickenella swartzii*
Noted October to December.

BROWN ROLL-RIM *Paxillus involutus*
Common in the observatory compound.

SULPHUR TUFT *Hypholoma fasciculare*
Noted in the observatory compound.

SHAGGY SCALYCAP *Pholiota squarrosa*
Noted December 19th.

FENDER FUNGUS *Melanotus (Psilocybe) horizontalis*
Noted October to December.

FIELD MUSHROOM *Agaricus campestris*
Noted October to December.

HORSE MUSHROOM *Agaricus arvensis*
Noted June 2nd & October to December.

YELLOW STAINER *Agaricus xanthodermus*
Noted October to December.

BROWN MOTTLEGILL *Panaeolina foenisecii*
Noted October to December.

HARE'SFOOT INKCAP *Coprinopsis lagopus*
Noted October 17th.

FAIRY INKCAP *Caprinellus disseminatus*
Noted November 27th.

WET ROT *Coniophora puteana*
Noted December.

TURKEY TAIL *Trametes versicolor*
Noted - common on cut privet, lilac & silver birch stumps.

MEADOW PUFFBALL *Lycoperdon (Vascellum) pretense*
Noted October to December.

GREY PUFFBALL *Bovista plumbea*
Noted October to December.

WINTER STALKBALL *Tulostoma brumale*
Noted February 16th. Later in the year 11 October 30th & another at a separate site
November 6th.

JELLY EAR *Auricularia auricula-judae*

Noted.

SILVERLEAF FUNGUS *Chondrostereum purpureum*

Noted December 19th.

Octospora rutilans

Noted October to December.

CORAL SPOT *Nectria cinnabarina*

Noted October to December.

CANDLESNUFF FUNGUS *Xylaria hypoxylon*

Noted from November in the same site as previous years.

DUNE WAXCAP *Hygrocybe conicoides*

Noted October to December.

Amphibians

SMOOTH NEWT *Lissotriton vulgaris*

Noted observatory from April 9th onwards, max. 12 May 8th.

FROG *Rana temporaria*

Noted in the Butts Pond from March 9th with spawn from 29th.

Reptiles

COMMON LIZARD *Lacerta vivipara*

Singles April 23rd, August 25th & 28th.

SLOW-WORM *Anguis fragilis*

One April 30th, two May 16th, one August 1st & one October 7th.

GRASS SNAKE *Natrix natrix*

Singles April 25th, May 19th, June 26th, July 26th, September 3rd, 5th & 29th.

Aranea

WASP SPIDER *Argiope bruennichi*

One on Butts August 27th & 28th.

CELLAR SPIDER *Pholocous phalangoides*

Noted inside locked buildings December 19th.

Orthoptera

DESERT LOCUST *Schistocerca gregaria*

Two August 24th & one 27th.

ROESEL'S BUSH-CRICKET *Metrioptera roeselii*

Noted July 15th.

SPECKLED BUSH-CRICKET *Leptophyes punctatissima*

Singles in the moth trap July 18th, August 5th, 16th, 18th, 25th, September 25th, 29th & October 6th.

OAK BUSH-CRICKET *Melonema thalassinum*

Singles in moth trap September 25th & November 8th.

Dictyoptera

LESSER COCKROACH *Ectobius panzeri*

Commonly recorded in the moth traps July 27th to October 2nd.

Dermaptera

COMMON EARWIG *Forficula auricularia*

Noted.

LESNE'S EARWIG *Forficula lesnes*

Noted in moth trap March 13th & from August 24th to October 18th.

Hemiptera

HAWTHORN SHIELDBUG *Acanthosoma haemorrhoidale*

One in moth trap August 27th.

GREEN BIRCH SHIELDBUG *Elasmotethus interstinctus*

Singles in the moth traps September 14th, 21st, two 25th, two 26th & one 27th.

COMMON GREEN SHIELDBUG *Palomena prasina*

Singles in moth trap October 6th & 9th.

RED LEGGED SHIELDBUG *Pentatoma rufipes*

One in moth trap September 4th.

Coleoptera

LESSER STAG BEETLE *Dorcus paralleripepedus*

One September 4th.

DEVIL'S COACH HORSE *Staphylinus olens*

Noted around the moth trap behind the kitchen in observatory compound. Singles in moth trap August 31st & September 28th.

SUMMER CHAFER *Amphimallon solstitialis*

619 noted in the moth traps June 30th to August 28th, max. 79 July 17th.

COCKCHAFER *Melolontha melolontha*

Four June 1st & singles 2nd, 17th & 19th.

HARLEQUIN LADYBIRD *Harmonia axyridis*

74 noted in the moth traps August 1st to September 27th, max. 10 August 11th & September 3rd..

SEXTON BEETLE *Nicrophorous humator*

Singles in moth trap June 12th & August 14th.

Diptera

BEE FLY *Villa modesta*

Singles in moth trap August 11th & 14th.

Volucella zonaria

Noted.

Hymenoptera

Cerceris arenaria

Colony by the observatory still present.

HORNET *Vespo carbo*

Singles October 7th, 8th, two 17th & singles 22nd, 29th, 30th & November 4th.
