# MISCELLANEOUS RECORDS AT LANDGUARD 2014

One April 13th, two May 15th, singles 19th, June 3rd, July 31st & September 28th.

FALSE WIDOW SPIDER Steatoda nobilis

365 in moth traps September 6th to October 31st, max 67 September 19th.

WESTERN CONIFER SEED BUG Leptoglossus occidentalis

21 noted in and around moth traps September 16th to 29th, max. 13 18th.

**RED LEGGED SHIELDBUG** Pentatoma rufipes

One in moth trap September 4th.

**COMMON GREEN SHIELDBUG** Palomena prasina

14 in moth traps May 14th to October 11th, max. two June 22nd.

GORSE SHIELDBUG Piezodorus lituratus

Two May 7th.

RHOMBIC LEATHERBUG Syromastes rhombeus
