CANDLESNUFF FUNGUS *Xylaria hypoxylon*

KING ALFRED'S CAKES *Daldinia concentrica*

On Holm Oak stumps 3rd February onwards.

RED-CRACKING BOLETE *Boletus chrysenteron*

Noted.

Amphibians

SMOOTH NEWT *Lissotriton vulgaris*

Noted observatory pond in all months except January & in Heligoland pond 5th May.

FROG *Rana temporaria*

Noted Butts Pond with spawn from February 26th.

Reptiles

COMMON LIZARD *Lacerta vivipara*

Singles April 19th, May 2nd & June 4th.

SLOW-WORM *Anguis fragilis*

Singles May 6th (dead), 9th, June 17th, 21st, 24th, July 30th, & October 10th.

GRASS SNAKE *Natrix natrix*

Singles May 10th, 26th, July 12th, September 20th & 26th.

Isopoda

SEA SLATER *Ligia oceanica*

One on boardwalk by the point January 24th.

Aranea

GRASS SPIDER *Tibellus oblongus*

One May 27th.

Thysanura

SILVERFISH *Lepisma saccharina*

Noted in the observatory ringing room & observatory office. One by notice board 6th June.

Orthoptera

SPECKLED BUSH-CRICKET *Leptophyes punctatissima*

One in the moth trap July 5th, two 21st, singles August 17th, 19th, October 22nd & 29th.

OAK BUSH-CRICKET *Meconema thalassinum*

One in moth trap August 16th.

COMMON FIELD GRASSHOPPER *Chorthippus brunneus*

One in moth trap September 1st.

Dictyoptera

LESSER COCKROACH *Ectobius panzeri*

Commonly recorded in the moth traps July 3rd into October.

Dermaptera

COMMON EARWIG *Forficula auricularia*

Noted.

LESNE'S EARWIG *Forficula lesnei*

Noted.

Hemiptera

HAWTHORN SHIELDBUG *Acanthosoma haemorrhoidale*

Total of 21 in moth traps April 15th to October 31st, max. three October 27th.

RED LEGGED SHIELDBUG *Pentatoma rufipes*

One in moth trap June 17th.

COMMON GREEN SHIELDBUG *Palomena prasina*

Singles in moth traps May 28th, June 16th & 17th.

DOCK BUG *Coreus marginatus*

Singles in moth traps June 6th & 17th.

WATER MEASURER *Hydrometra stagnorum*

Noted in water tub.

Coleoptera

HARLEQUIN LADYBIRD *Harmonia axyridis*

46 noted in the moth traps July 15th to October 8th, max. seven July 26th.

DEVIL'S COACH HORSE *Ocypus olens*

Noted around the moth trap behind the kitchen in observatory compound.

SUMMER CHAFER *Amphimallon solstitialis*

232 noted in moth traps June 23rd to August 12th, max. 28 July 2nd.

COCKCHAFER *Melolontha melolontha*

Singles in moth traps May 24th, 25th, June 8th, 14th & 28th.

GREAT DIVING BEETLE *Dytiscus marginalis*

One in moth trap April 2nd.

7-SPOT LADYBIRD *Coccinella 7-punctata*

One in moth trap September 26th.

2-SPOT LADYBIRD *Adalia bipunctata*

Singles in moth traps May 21st, July 31st, August 17th & 28th.

10-SPOT LADYBIRD *Adalia 10-punctata*

In moth traps five July 2nd, three 5th, one 16th & one 17th.

ORANGE LADYBIRD *Halysia 16-guttata*

Singles in moth traps June 30th & July 2nd.

SEXTON BEETLE *Nicrophorous sp.*

Regular in moth traps.

Diptera

BEE FLY *Villa modesta*

Singles in moth trap July 16th, 18th, August 16th & September 19th.

HORNET HOVERFLY *Volucella zonaria*

Noted.

MARMALADE HOVERFLY *Episyrphus balteatus*

200+ July 16th.

Hymenoptera

Cerceris arenaria

Colony by the observatory still present.

BEEWOLF *Philanthus triangulum*

One August 20th.

HORNET *Vespo carbo*

Singles September 15th & October 15th.

Bombus lapidarius

Female in moth trap May 1st.
