

MISCELLANEOUS RECORDS AT LANDGUARD 1992

The following is a summary of miscellaneous casual records of a variety of species in the Landguard recording area during 1992. Many sightings, particularly of common species, go undocumented and the species list and dates should be treated as an absolute minimum.

Reptiles

SLOW WORM *Anguis fragilis*

Male August 14th was the first seen for several years

Mammals

HEDGEHOG *Erinaceus europaeus*

Following on from last year's increase in sightings, noted from March 5th to April 29th, after which one found drowned July 20th and one dead on View Point Road November 25th

Small Bat sp.

One May 15th

COMMON SEAL *Phoca vitulina*

One on the point January 31st was unusual. Between April and September regularly seen on the Cork Sands when tides and good light permitted, max. 14 April 20th, also one later one on November 8th

GREY SQUIRREL *Sciurus carolinensis*

One June 7th
