

# MISCELLANEOUS RECORDS AT LANDGUARD 2019

This a summary of miscellaneous casual records of a variety of species in the Landguard recording area during 2019. Many sightings, particularly of common species, go undocumented and the species and dates should be treated as an absolute minimum.

## Plants

**STINKING GOOSEFOOT** *Chenopodium vulvaria*

86 July 20th & 118 August 10th. All in an area on the seaward side of the Butts.

**PYRAMIDAL ORCHID** *Anacamptis pyramidalis*

Two on the Butts July 2nd (plus other dates).

## Fungi

**DEADLY DAPPERLING** *Lepiota brunneoincarnata*

October 12th.

**DUNE DAPPERLING** *Lepiota erminea*

October 14th.

**EARTHY POWDERCAP** *Cystoderma amianthinum*

October 14th.

**HORSE HAIR PARACHUTE** *Marasmius androsaceus*

October 14th.

**FOOL'S FUNNEL** *Clitocybe rivulosa*

December 7th.

**DUNE BRITTLESTEM** *Psathyrella ammopila*

October 14th.

**DOG SICK SLIME MOULD** *Fuligo septica*

January 1st.

**FALSE PUFFBALL** *Reticularia lycoperdon*

Noted April.

## Amphibians

**SMOOTH NEWT** *Lissotriton vulgaris*

Noted observatory pond April 22nd.

**FROG** *Rana temporaria*

Spawn Butts Pond from March 9th in much smaller quantities.

## Reptiles

**COMMON LIZARD** *Zootoca vivipara*

Several on the Butts with dates not noted.

## Molluscs

**GREEN CELLAR SLUG** *Limacus maculatus*

Noted from March 17th. Probably quite common. Regular in actinic moth trap.

## Dictyoptera

**LESSER COCKROACH** *Ectobius panzeri*

Commonly recorded in the moth traps.

### Dermaptera

**COMMON EARWIG** *Forficula auricularia*

Noted.

**LESNE'S EARWIG** *Forficula lesnei*

Noted.

### Hemiptera

**HAWTHORN SHIELDBUG** *Acanthosoma haemorrhoidale*

Regularly noted in moth traps or sitting on mist nets May 26th to October 12th.

**GREEN BIRCH SHIELDBUG** *Elasmotethus intersinctus*

Two in moth trap September 16th.

**WESTERN CONIFER SEED-BUG** *Leptoglossus occidentalis*

In moth traps three August 25th, one 27th & two September 16th.

**RED-LEGGED SHIELDBUG** *Pentatoma rufipes*

Noted June 2nd to July 26th, max. eight July 25th.

**COMMON GREEN SHIELDBUG** *Palomena prasina*

Noted on 15 dates February 20th to October 9th.

**BOX BUG** *Gonocerus acuteangulatus*

Singles July 21st & October 23rd.

**DOCK BUG** *Coreus marginatus*

Noted May 9th & 13th.

### Coleoptera

**HARLEQUIN LADYBIRD** *Harmonia axyridis*

103 noted in the moth traps May 26th to October 5th, max. 14 July 23rd.

**ORANGE LADYBIRD** *Halysia 16-guttata*

Singles in moths trap June 25th & August 2nd.

**DEVIL'S COACH HORSE** *Ocyopus olens*

Noted around the moth trap behind the kitchen in observatory compound.

**SUMMER CHAFER** *Amphimallon solstitialis*

72 noted in moth traps June 7th to August 2nd, max. nine July 5th.

**COCKCHAFER** *Melolontha melolontha*

Three in moth traps June 10th to 16th.

### Diptera

**DUNE VILLA** *Villa modesta*

Noted.

**HORNET HOVERFLY** *Volucella zonaria*

Noted.

### Hymenoptera

**HORNET** *Vespa carbo*

Singles September 12th & October 10th.

### Araneae

**WASP SPIDER** *Argiope bruennichi*

Four in observatory compound near notice board.
