

## LANDGUARD BIRD OBSERVATORY - Ringing Recoveries

(up to 31/12/2025)

The following is a summary of the recoveries that have been received for birds ringed or recovered at Landguard. For each species totals are given for the number of birds that have moved more than 20km to or from Landguard and these are shown by country or English county. There then follows a selection of the recoveries. For the recoveries the top line shows the ringing details - ring number / age and sex / date / locality, and the second line shows the recovery details - manner of recovery / date / locality, followed by the distance and direction of the movement. If the date of recovery is not known the date that the ring was reported to the BTO is shown in brackets.
